Program Successes

For the Year Ending June 30, 2009



The programs of Walker's Point Youth & Family Center served a record 692 youth with face-to-face services, including 278 youth to whom we provided either emergency shelter and/or transitional housing.

94% of youth left the emergency or transitional living shelters to return home or to a safe and acceptable home.

IN THE RUNAWAY & TEEN CRISIS EMERGENCY SHELTER PROGRAM:

73% of youth who received individual or family counseling (whether on a resident or non-resident basis) were assessed by program staff as having made at least minor progress in dealing with their problems.

89% of resident youth felt that their stay in the emergency shelter was helpful to them.

88% of all youth who were provided in-depth street outreach services made positive changes reducing their risk for sexual abuse and exploitation.

IN THE TRANSITIONAL LIVING PROGRAM:

"It was a good place and I will always remember it."

91% of residents made progress on their counseling goals as assessed by staff at time of discharge.

85% of residents had made progress on their educational goals by the time they left the program.

84% of youth ages 18-21 years old had made progress on their work goals and were in paid employment at time of discharge.

IN THE FAMILY SUPPORT AND EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM:

Between the beginning and end of the Nurturing Program series, participant results on the test measures showed that

84% of both parents and teens increased their scores reflecting gains in nurturing parenting concepts and/or skills.
